

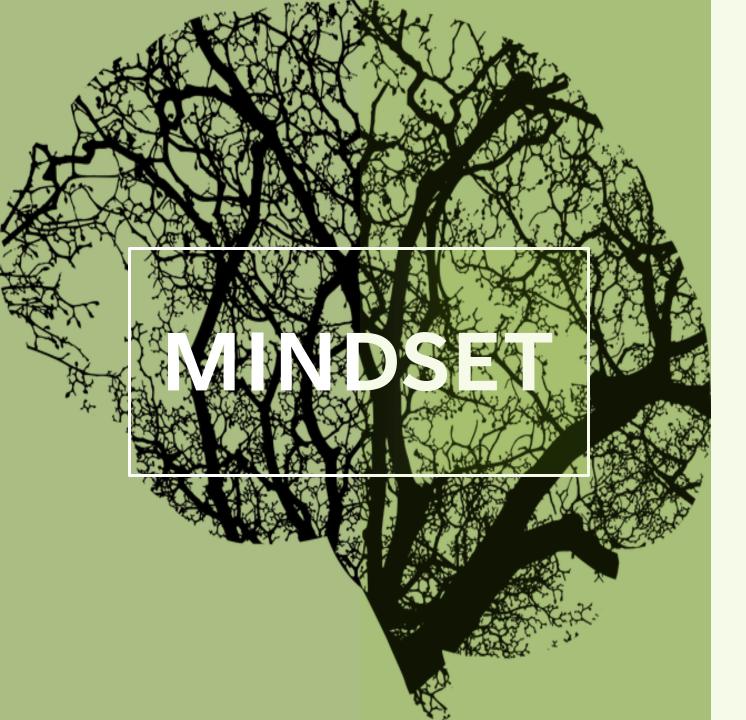

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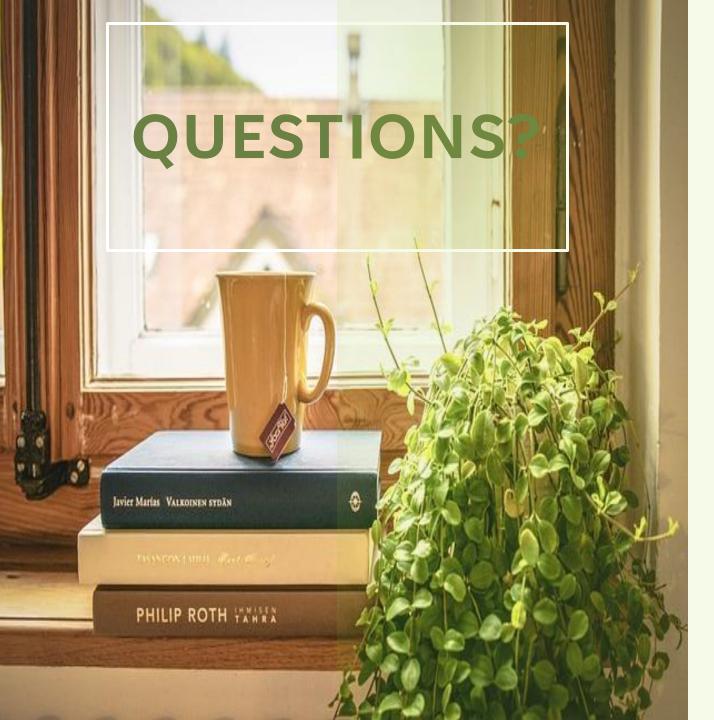
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If you don't yet have the answers to the MIRROR questions, that's GREAT! Creating a compelling bio provides an opportunity to discover answers you SHOULD have.
